

Our Mission: Empowering Communities Through Education

Our mission is to identify impoverished and needy children, enroll them in school, and support them from kindergarten through high school. By keeping children off the streets and equipping them with fundamental skills, we empower them to become self-sufficient and productive members of society.



Program Impact Highlights

In 2025, Uplift A Child achieved several key milestones that strengthened our ability to support children and families. Through new and expanded partnerships, we increased our sponsorship capacity and welcomed around 180 additional children into our program, ensuring they received the educational support necessary for continued success.

Our team conducted numerous school visits, providing direct engagement with students, monitoring academic progress, and fostering strong relationships with educators and families. These visits remain a vital component of our model, enabling us to offer timely guidance and ensure each child receives the support they need.

To further enhance students' confidence and sense of belonging, we facilitated the distribution of school uniforms, helping children feel prepared, included, and supported in their learning environments.

Collectively, these achievements underscore our commitment to delivering consistent, high-quality support and advancing our mission to uplift children through education.



We provided books and uniforms for **more than 1000 children**, giving them not just the tools for learning but also the dignity, confidence, and pride to walk into school each day ready to shine

Volunteer-Led Fundraiser at Saint Louis University (USA)

On November 9th, our dedicated volunteer at Saint Louis University, **Srisupraja and her team** organized a meaningful fundraiser during the campus's annual Diwali Program. The event beautifully combined cultural celebration with service, drawing strong participation from students and community members.



Through a combination of ticket sales, a jhumka fundraiser, and generous anonymous donations, the initiative raised \$400 in support of Uplift a Child. Most of the contributions came from \$5 event tickets, reflecting enthusiastic engagement from the campus community. The jhumka fundraiser, though a smaller portion of the total, added a thoughtful and creative touch to the overall effort.

The funds raised through this event are now being used to support Heronika an child from Vizag, helping provide her with access to education, basic necessities, and family support. This student-led initiative demonstrated the real impact of community-based fundraising and highlighted the importance of transparency and awareness. At the ticketing table, the volunteer team intentionally shared information about Uplift a Child's mission, ensuring attendees understood how their contributions would directly benefit a child in need.

The Diwali Program itself was a vibrant celebration of South Asian culture, featuring multiple dance performances, a singing group, and a joyful finale with sparklers. The evening brought together students in a memorable moment of unity, pride, and purpose. This fundraiser stands as a powerful example of how young people across the world can champion our mission and create meaningful change — one event, one child, and one act of kindness at a time.

ABOUT OUR CHILDREN IN THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

We are deeply saddened by the conflict between the Democratic Republic of Congo and Rwanda in 2025. We continue to pray for a peaceful resolution and for life to return to normal in both countries. This conflict caused children in the DRC to lose an entire year of schooling. Despite extremely limited resources, our local volunteers worked tirelessly to coordinate and provide essential support, even while schools remained closed.

Uplift a Child began its work in Kemembe, a small town located 240 kilometers from Rwanda's capital city, Kigali. During our CEO's 2024 visit to Africa, 60 children in this community were identified as needing educational support. Most of these children come from underprivileged families and it is our privilege to help them.

In 2025, we proudly supported all 60 children, and with our partnership, they are now excelling in their studies. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to Mr. Emmanuel for his dedication in coordinating support and volunteering his time to help Uplift a Child serve children in Rwanda.

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

During the 2025 fiscal year, Uplift A Child raised a total of **\$298,372** through the generous support of our donors, partners, and well-wishers. Program and operational expenses amounted to \$291,853, enabling us to deliver essential educational support and services to children across our global programs.

This resulted in a **surplus of \$6,519**, which will be carried forward to strengthen upcoming initiatives and ensure continuity of support for the children we serve.

The funds raised this year directly **benefited 1,277 children** across India, Nepal, DR Congo, Rwanda, and Kenya—providing access to education, school supplies, uniforms, and ongoing guidance through our sponsorship and engagement programs.


